Tutorial DVDs

These DVDs are a very good method for learning how to use Photoshop and are produced to a high standard by Beckham Digital whose web site is <http://www.beckhamdigital.co.uk/>. The DVDs are usable only on your PCs and give well structured visual instruction for many of the tools and functions within Photoshop. They will also be useful for people with Photoshop Elements as many of the tools are common to both programs. More details of the DVDs' content is shown below.



Photoshop CS-2 Volume 1 When you are first introduced to Photoshop CS2 you can be forgiven for not knowing where to start and you can be overwhelmed. This DVD comes to the rescue with **2 Hours and 30 minutes** of video presented at a starter DVD with all the relevant subjects included under different menus.



Photoshop CS-2 Volume 2 Here the tutorials are aimed more at the intermediate user of Photoshop, or at least those who have mastered the basics of this powerful software. The DVD follows on from Volume 1 and we show you some great techniques in this DVD that is packed with **3 hours and 40 minutes** of high resolution video.
